- The processing of British Registration Applications has been suspended as the UK Home Office has suspended their diplomatic mail arrangements
- Following the closure of the Government Administration Building, the submission of applications has been suspended until further notice

All applications for Naturalisation/Registration as a BOTC which were previously submitted will continue to be processed up to the ceremony stage. Once we are back in office arrangements for ceremonies will be made and successful applicants will be advised accordingly.

We apologise for any inconvenience that these disruptions in service may cause, but encourage you all to lend the Government your full support as they seek to protect the People of the Cayman Islands.
